Clear, bright pale yellow, when exposed to the light it brings out slight hints of green trims. On the nose is intense, with hints of apricots and peaches, with the freshness of citrus and the scents of Spring flowers. On the palate is fresh, mineral, with balanced acidity, layered with herbs and citrus and with a lingering finish.

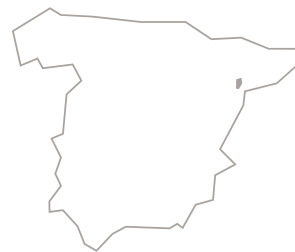

Clear, dark purple colour. Pure and very intense aromas reminiscent of red berry fruit such as cranberries, red cherries and raspberries combined with mineral notes of flint and hints of eucalyptus. The palate is dry, full bodied with rich concentrated juicy fruit, firm but ripe tannins and a refreshing acidity.

Clear, deep dark purple colour.
Pure and very intense aromas reminiscent of black berry fruit, red cherries and raspberries, combined with mineral notes of flint, and hints of eucalyptus in elegant combination with toasted oak, spices, tobacco and coffee beans. The palate is dry, full bodied with rich concentrated juicy fruit, firm but ripe tannins and a refreshing acidity making this a great food wine that will age very well for the next 12-16 years.
